TOURNAMENT RULES – USBC CARDS ARE REQUIRED

1. **MULTIPLE ENTRIES.** Multiple entries will be allowed in Team Event, Doubles and Singles. No more than two (2) players on a team will place more than once for position standings. Doubles & Singles: In no case shall the same 2-woman team be permitted to place more than once in position standings. In no case shall the same individual be permitted to place more than once for the Single position standings. Doubles and Singles are separate events.
2. **AVERAGES.** You must be a sanctioned member of the NCFUSBCWBA. NCFUSBCWBA 2010-2011 yearbook averages shall be used. If no yearbook average, highest average of at least 21 games as of December 31, 2011 shall be used. If no December 31, 2011 average, a summer of 2011 average of at least 21 games may be used. Next would be highest average of at least 21 games prior to entry deadline, otherwise all others shall bowl scratch and shall be placed in Division I. The ten-pin rule will be in effect for this tournament, based on Dec. 31, 2011. Handicap will be 85% of the difference of the average and 200. The NCFUSBCWBA Board of Directors shall determine any exceptions.
3. **ALL-EVENTS – TROPHY.** Entry in all three events automatically qualifies you for the Scratch trophy and the Handicap trophy; the same bowler may win both. Trophies will be awarded in each division.
4. **ALL-EVENTS – CASH.** The All-Events cash prizes apply only to the bowlers paying the \$3.00 entry fee for All-Events Scratch and/or Handicap. When a bowler competes more than once, the first appearance in each event shall count towards the All-Events score. Cash prizes will be awarded by division in which paid.
5. **ORDER OF BOWLING.** Tournament entrants must bowl in the order in which their names appear on the entry form. Team captains shall be responsible for verification of proper line-up. In case of a substitution, the substitute must take the place in the line-up of the original entrant. A substitute will not be required by the NCFUSBCWBA to reimburse the original entrant for any entry fees or prize monies won.
6. **CHECK-IN TIME.** All bowlers are required to check in 30 minutes prior to their scheduled starting time. Team Captains are to check in teams after all members are present at the lanes. Doubles partners are to check in together.
7. **TIES. First Place Only.** Teams, Doubles and Singles will be rolled off with a 3 game series within one week after the close of the tournament. Time to be set by those involved and the tournament manager. This will be at tournament expense. Total pins plus handicap declares a winner.
8. **LATE BOWLERS.** Any bowler who arrives after the scheduled shift has started will be permitted to bowl. Her score will count beginning with the frame being bowled; no score will be given for the frames missed.
9. **SUBSTITUTES.** House Tournament Manager should be notified as soon as it is known that a substitute is to be used.
10. **OPEN BOWLING.** There will be no open bowling by participants on the lanes assigned two (2) hours prior to the tournament.
11. **WARM-UP BOWLING.** Ten (10) minutes will be allowed on the starting lanes. Throw only one ball on each lane and rotate. Doubles will be bowled first and then Singles. Singles will be bowled on the same pair as doubles. Those bowling only singles or only doubles will not be mixed in with those bowling both events together.
12. **UNOPPOSED.** In the event a team is unopposed on a pair of lanes, each frame will be completed before the next frame is started on the adjoining lane. This rule applies to Doubles and Singles Events also. **No pacers allowed.**
13. **ENTRIES ARE PROCESSED ON A FIRST- COME BASIS.** After entries have been received and dates assigned, no fees shall be refunded and no change will be made in the entrant's scheduled time, except in an emergency, the NCFUSBCWBA Tournament Manager must approve any change. Any appeal or protest shall be made in writing and submitted to the NCFUSBCWBA Tournament Manager not later than 24 hours after occurrence.
14. **RETURNED CHECKS.** Any check returned prior to bowling will result in a \$20.00 assessment fee and disqualification of that entry until the delinquent amount has been paid. Any check returned after bowling will result in forfeiture of any winnings, a \$20.00 assessment fee, and the bowler may be subject to USBC charges.
15. **PROPER ATTIRE REQUIRED. SHORTS AND/OR SKIRTS SHALL BE NO SHORTER THAN 4 INCHES ABOVE THE KNEE. THIS RULE WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED. SHIRTS MUST HAVE SLEEVES OF SOME SORT.**
16. **AWARDS PRESENTATION AND ANNUAL MEETING.** Will be held at Alley Katz on Sunday, March 25, 2012 at 3:00PM following the Second Chance Tournament at 1PM. Cash awards and trophies will be awarded at this time.

NOTE: The NCFUSBCWBA Board of Directors will decide any rule not covered by these Rules.
